

Sample Projects Project Development

2010

The GreenTech team was involved in the development of the first wind and solar plants in Jordan, Bahrain, and Egypt. The projects ranged from 50-110 MW and included MWh scale battery storage.

Waste to Energy

2020

GreenTech is developing several waste-to-energy projects in the middle east and Eastern Africa. The technology used is direct incineration and follows eu2010/75 environmental standard. The projects range between 1000 to 4000 tons/day producing up to 130mw of electricity.

2014

GreenTech developed the outreach programs and initiatives for this USAID-funded project entitled 'Public Action for water, energy and environment'. Under this initiative, GreenTech managed a social marketing campaign to encourage energy and water efficiency at Jordanian industrial companies.

WEFE Nexus Hub

2020

Greentech, in collaboration with INWRDAM, are co-developing the WEFE Nexus Hub, which will serve the member states of INWRDAM and the UfM.
